### **Job Description:**

Platte-Clay Electric currently has two openings for Journeyman Lineman positions, one at the Kearney office and one at the Platte City office. The Journeyman Lineman will be required to perform all types of work involved in the construction, maintenance, and operation of the Co-op’s electric system. The Lineman will perform various duties related to member service including making service changes, troubleshooting service outages, carrying out voltage tests and completing outage reports. Knowledge of REA specifications are preferred. A safe working environment will be maintained by adhering to policies, procedures, and regulations.

### **Job Qualifications:**

- High School diploma or equivalent
- Graduate of an approved electric distribution program and have successfully completed a four-year electric lineman apprenticeship program
- Valid Class A Commercial Drivers License. If a Class A CDL is not issued by the State of Missouri, must be able to transfer it to the State of Missouri.
- Must live within 30 minutes of the service area center

### **Work Schedule:**

Normal operational hours are Monday-Friday, 7:30 a.m.-4:00 p.m. Journeyman Lineman participate in an on-call rotation and may be called in to work during outages and emergencies.
